SUMMARY OF DUTIES

The mission is seeking to fill a Maintenance Technician position for the common services program as well as various general services positions that may arise following this selection process. The Maintenance Technician provides general maintenance services and assists with/performs repairs on crown-owned or leased assets and equipment in areas such as carpentry, masonry, painting, plumbing, electrical, HVAC, and mechanical systems and other duties as required.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Education

This position requires:

Minimum Secondary School education Advanced Level from a legally recognized Secondary/High School

OR

NVQ level 05 equivalent vocational training in a recognized institute in HVAC/Electrical/mechanical

Note: Candidates will be required to provide proof of their education

Language
