### SOFTWARE ENGINEER

**General Conditions:**

Applicants must:

**Nature of Appointment:**

This appointment will be on a contract basis for a period of one (01) year, which may be extended for a further period of one (01) year based on performance and service requirement.

**Educational Qualifications:**

A Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science / Software Engineering / Information Technology or an equivalent qualification recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of Sri Lanka.

**Experience:**

Applicants should have:

- A minimum of Five (05) years experience in software engineering, development, and system implementation.
- Experience in web-based application development, database management, and system integration.
- Experience in cybersecurity practices and API development.
- Experience in healthcare system design and development, including digital platform integration, with strong exposure to payment gateway integration.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

The selected candidate will be required to:

- Design, develop, implement, and maintain software systems and digital platforms of the SLMC.
- Ensure database integrity, system security, and compliance with data protection requirements.
- Develop and maintain APIs and integrate external services such as payment gateways and SMS systems.

- Carry out any other duties assigned by the management of the SLMC.
